(i.e.) 22nd/24th October 1971	-	Training Weekend Map Reading
3rd/5th March 1972	-	Training Weekend General Expedition
30th March/3rd April 1972	-	Expedition Tests in Snowdonia for Boys of 14 years and over at Easter.

It is hoped that the Map Reading Training Weekend will be held at The Station Sick Quarters, R.A.F. West Malling.
