The dates for the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Expedition Training and Tests during the coming session are as follows:-

- 22nd - 23rd October, 1977 - Training Weekend, Map Reading - BRONZE LEVEL.  
5th - 6th November, 1977 - " " " " - SILVER & GOLD LEVEL.  
11th - 12th February 1978 - Training Weekend, General Expedition - SILVER & GOLD LEVEL  
25th - 26th " " " " " " - BRONZE LEVEL.  
23rd - 26th March, 1978 - Expedition Tests (all levels) in Snowdonia for boys/girls of 14 years and over at Easter.

The Map Reading Training weekends will be held at Snodland Youth Club, Snodland, Kent. Reception will be from 07.45 hours to 08.00 on the Saturday morning and departure at 17.00 hours on the Sunday.

It is important that all boys/girls should arrive promptly and be sure to bring with them their D.E.A. Record Book.

Will you please note that boys/girls must attend the Map Training weekend to be eligible for the General Expedition weekend.

In order to carry out the necessary administration and let the instructors have the information, it is essential that the enclosed forms are returned, properly completed, to me NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, 7th OCTOBER, 1977, and be accompanied by the appropriate remittances.
