Final arrangements have been made for the Easter Expedition in Snowdonia.

The Coach will leave from the rear of Milton Road Methodist Church, Milton Road, Gravesend. Please be there at 5.30 a.m. to leave at 6.00 a.m. SHARP on Easter Thursday morning, the 12th April. It will return on Sunday night, arriving back to Gravesend at approximately 6.00 on Easter Monday morning.

Transport to and from North Wales will be by Coach and Private cars. If you wish your son/daughter to travel there and back by Coach only, will you please notify me of this when you return your Form and monies.

The Expedition Fee is:- Gold level - £10.00 per head.  
Silver level - £8.50 per head.
