The dates for the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Expedition Training and Tests during the coming session are as follows:

18th - 19th October, 1980	- Training Weekend, Map Reading	- BRONZE LEVEL
1st - 2nd November, 1980	- " " " "	- SILVER & GOLD LEVEL
28th Feb. - 1st March, 1981	- Training Weekend, General Expedition	- SILVER & GOLD LEVEL
14th - 15th March, 1981	- " " " "	- BRONZE LEVEL
16th - 19th April, 1981	- Expedition Tests (all levels) in Snowdonia for boys/girls of 14 years and over at Easter.	

All of the Training Weekends will be held at Snodland Youth Club, Snodland, Kent.

Reception will be from 07.45 hours to 08.00 on the Saturday morning and departure at 17.00 on the Sunday.

It is important that all boys/girls should arrive promptly and be sure to bring with them their D.E.A. Record Book.

Will you please note that boys/girls must attend the Map Reading Training Weekend to be eligible for the General Expedition Weekend.

As our total number of participants for this year is, at present, unknown, it should be noted that if demand exceeds our capacity for the Easter expeditions preference will be given to Gold Level and Silver Level candidates.

In order to carry out the necessary administration and let the instructors have the information, it is essential that the enclosed forms are returned, properly completed, to me NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 26TH SEPTEMBER, 1980 and be accompanied by the remittance of £2.00 per head. If your company has no entrants this session, I would appreciate notification of this also by 26th September, 1980.
