Dear Captain/Assessor/Instructor,


I am enclosing herewith copies of the programme for the forthcoming Training Weekends.

There are a few points which should be noted and your help in following these will be appreciated.

- a) All boys/girls should be dropped off at Addington Green and left to walk in to the premises to avoid congestion of cars. Assessors with cars should park them in the designated area. All directions will be posted.
- b) No boots, of any sort, will be worn by anybody, except when going out on training expedition. Soft shoes, plimsolls, even slippers must be brought and used instead. Also a change of clothing should be brought to enable a change to be made in case of muddy conditions.
- c) Assessors/Instructors will be walking with groups and should come equipped to do so.
