Notes for Meeting being held on Monday 21st March, 1983 at Knightrider Street Baptist Church, Maidstone.

EASTER TRANSPORT - Coach arriving Gravesend at 5.30 a.m. to leave 6 a.m. PROMPT. Surplus rucksacs in with A.PRICE. G.BARCLAY in charge of Coach together with 9 other Assessors. Stops en route - Assessor sheets given out here - 1 only - Watford Gap Service Station. Report to Robert here. All cars expected at Gravesend at 5.30 a.m. unless Robert notified otherwise. Any problems en route 'phone Jill Price on Medway 70543 and leave message. Drivers log sheet will be provided-we will pay all D.E.A. mileage- not running around between checks. Float available from Robert if required. Balance of all petrol costs will be paid, by cheque, at the end of the weekend. Total numbers - 33 Assessors, 19 trainee Assessors, 3 Cooks, 47 Silver, 12 Gold - Total 104. A list of groups and routes they are on will be/is supplied. Assessors to make sure they catch their car/coach home as detailed.

FOOD & ACCOMMODATION - Cooking and equipment arranged by Dick - 3 cooks, namely Linda, Pat and Bobby. Remember your Thermos Flasks and teatowels, also lunch box. Accommodation is at BrynDdu again - Tel: Llanberis 370454. Alan Fishwick to allocate rooms on arrival. No breakfasts served after 9 a.m. Inform cooks if early breakfast required. All second year assessors and trainee Assessors to bring a camper mat or lilo to sleep on. NO Camp beds.

EQUIPMENT.- All Assessors to be properly equipped and clothed and able to cope with any emergency including overnight stay out, i.e. Survival bag, Sleeping bag, First Aid Kit, emergency rations, clothings. Emergency Tent to stay on base. Please take your I.D. card with you - if you don't have one, please see Bernard Gore.

BASE CAMP/TELEPHONE DUTY.- Group of Assessors and cars arranged on base each day. Their responsibilities are:-

- 1) Full responsibility for all young people not on expedition.
- 2) Preparation of group about to start expeditions, ensuring groups going out have their I.D. Cards, orange cards and emergency 'phone number, and that they are ready in good time for transport to their starting point.
3. To arrange manning of the telephone from 9.00 until the last group has finished each day, and to ensure that at all times at least 1 car and assessors are available for emergencies.

TELEPHONING IN - A.FISHWICK.- To ensure that telephone is working O.K. for incoming calls. All Assessors to note the number - Llanberis 370454.

Make sure all groups, especially those leaving Thursday, have the number. Every group of Assessors to 'phone in regularly - that is -

- 1) After every check
- 2) At least once every two hours.
- 3) before leaving an area
- 4) Before returning to Base.
