Final arrangements have been made for the Silver & Gold level expeditions in Snowdonia at Easter. The travelling arrangements are as follows:-

GOLD LEVEL ONLY-Coach departs at 10a.m. on WEDNESDAY 22nd MARCH from LEYBOURNE LAY-BY, LEYBOURNE, Nr. WEST MALLING (Map ref. 690590-on A228 just south of M.20).

SILVER LEVEL ONLY-Coach departs at 6 a.m. on THURSDAY 23rd MARCH from LEYBOURNE LAY-BY, LEYBOURNE, Nr. WEST MALLING (Map ref. 690590-on A228 just south of M.20).

To ensure a prompt departure time please be there 20/30 minutes before your appropriate departure time to give time for loading.

Both Coaches will be returning at the same time and it is expected we shall arrive back in Kent at approximately 12 midnight/1 a.m. Sunday 26th March. I suggest that you arrange to 'phone your parents or BB/GB Officer from the Motorway stop on the way home to give them a more accurate expected time of arrival.


The Expedition fee is:- Gold level £22.50, Silver level, £21.00. An equipment list and application form are enclosed.
