Notes for Meeting being held on Monday, 13th March, 1989 at
Knightrider Street Baptist Church, Maidstone.

TRANSPORT - TO and FROM WALES - Transport arrangements as per list. There will be 2 Coaches this year, one will depart at 10 a.m. on WEDNESDAY, 22nd MARCH and the other on THURSDAY, 23rd MARCH, at 6 a.m. All golds plus some assessors travelling on Wednesday. All silver plus assessors on the Thursday. Coach will also be picking up in Essex at M25/A13 Junction. S. Vigar, D. Cooke, H. Cocks, to be in charge of Wednesday Coach and A. Holmes, K. Sinden in charge of Thursday coach. Coaches will be dropping off groups en route and MUST therefore be loaded accordingly. There will be one stop en route, that is Watford Gap Service Area. Assessing Sheets will be handed out there. Please see S. Brookes, (Wed) and R. Hardy (Thurs) at the Service Area. Any problems en route 'phone JILL PRICE on MEDWAY 710543 and leave message. Total numbers attending are:- 27 Assessors, 3 Cooks, 37 Silver, 41 Gold, Total 108. Petrol costs will be paid by cheque at the end of the weekend.

FOOD and ACCOMMODATION - Same accommodation this year as last - the address is:- JESSE JAMES' BUNKHOUSE, PENISARWAEN, CAERNARVON. Tel: LLANBERIS (0286) 870521. Map ref. 566638. It is a non-smoking house and we are requested to observe this and any other rules there may be. NYE PRICE will organise and allocate rooms. We shall be accommodating and feeding the Coach drivers again this year. Cooking & equipment organised by HELEN and GRAHAM, the 3 cooks are PAT, DEBRA, and BOBBY. Please remember to bring Thermos Flask, tea towel and lunch box. No breakfasts after 9 a.m. Please inform Cooks if early breakfast is required. No meals on Wednesday - first meal supplied will be Thursday evening.

EQUIPMENT - All assessors to be properly equipped and clothed and be able to cope with any emergency including overnight stay out i.e. Survival bag and Sleeping Bag, first aid kit, emergency rations, clothing. Emergency tent and rucksack to stay on base in case of emergency. Please take your I.D. card with you - if you don't have one please see Bernard Gore.

BASE CAMP/TELEPHONE DUTY - Groups of Assessors and Cars arranged on base each day. Their responsibilities are:-
1. Full responsibility for all young people not on Expedition.
2. Preparation of groups about to start expeditions, ensuring groups going out have their I.D. cards, orange cards and emergency 'phone No. and that they are ready in good time for Transport to their starting point.
3. To arrange manning of the telephone from 9 a.m. until the last group has finished each day and to ensure that at all times at least one car and assessors are available for emergencies.

TELEPHONING IN - Make sure all groups especially those leaving en route on Wed. and Thurs. have the number. Each group of assessors to 'phone in regularly, that is:- 1. after every check. 2. At least every two hours. 3. Before leaving an area. 4. Before returning to base.

ASSESSING TECHNIQUES - Assessing techniques will continue as last year. Groups should only be contacted at the camp sites in the evening (except in cases of emergency or if problems are suspected). Assessors to make visual contact only at all the other check points and collect orange cards. Assessing forms to be filled in completely and returned to the groups' files on base each evening.

SERVICE - A Service will be arranged for Good Friday at 9 p.m. for all Assessors. A brief informal Meeting will be held on the other evenings to report on groups progress that day.

LOGS & LOG MEETING - Separate list shows groups of Assessors receiving logs. Logs to be studied by that Group returned if necessary for correction & brought with Record Books for signing to the Logs Meeting at Alan Fishwick's house, 14 Bowermount Rd. Maidstone on Wed. 31st May at 7.30 p.m.
