Last November a small band of eager assessors headed down the M4 to South Wales for a weekend of walking in the Brecon Beacons and Black Mountains.

The rewards included zero visibility and drizzle on Pen-y-Fan and a full-blown blizzard on Sugar Loaf! Unfortunately the rest of the weekend didn't live up to the same standard and too much time was spent socialising, enjoying good food and magnificent scenery.

This November (the weekend of the 24th-26th) I am organising a trip to the Peak District, but with some changes to the arrangements.

I have booked accommodation at Warslow (in the White Peak area) for 15 people. You'll be pleased to learn that this doesn't involve the use of beds, but is in fact a carping barn offering no trappings of civilisation other than a roof, sleeping platforms, table, bench, cooking area, tap and toilet.

The cost will be £5.00 per person (payable on booking) which covers 2 nights accommodation and basic food items.

If you haven't been to this area before, the walking is easy through typical White Peak dales and moors - but don't worry, since it's easier than last time we should be able to squeeze in a few more miles! The National Park has its own very distinctive identity and I know you'll love the landscape and attractive villages. As last year, I would hope to do a good walk on the Saturday with something a little slower on Sunday.

I do hope you can join me. With only 15 spaces available you'll need to book quickly or else you might have to sort out your own accommodation. Just return the slip to me with your cheque and I'll send you full details.
