

SILVER & GOLD EXPEDITIONS - EASTER 1990

Notes for meeting being held on Monday 2nd April 1990 at Knightrider Street Baptist Church, Maidstone.

TRANSPORT - TO and FROM WALES - Transport arrangements as per list. There will be 2 coaches this year, one will depart at 9 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY 11 APRIL** and the other on **THURSDAY 12 APRIL** at 6 a.m. All Gold and one Silver group plus 15 assessors travelling on Wednesday. All other Silver groups and remaining assessors on the Thursday. **A. HOLMES** will be in charge of Wednesday coach and **K. SINDBW** will be in charge of Thursday coach. The Thursday coach will be dropping off groups en route and **MUST** therefore be packed accordingly. There will be one stop en route, that is Watford Gap Service Area. Assessing sheets will be handed out there on Thursday, please see R. Hardy. If you encounter any problems during the journey please ring Nye & Jill Price on Medway 710543 and leave a message. Total numbers attending are:- 30 assessors, 4 cooks, 9 trainee assessors, 41 Silver, 28 Gold = Total 112. Petrol costs will be paid by cheque at the end of the weekend.

FOOD and ACCOMMODATION - Same as last year - **JESSE JAMES' BUNKHOUSE, PENISARWAEN, CARNARVON**. Tel: Llanberis (0286) 870521. Map Ref. 566638. It is a non-smoking house and we are requested to observe this and any other rules there may be. **ALAN FISHWICK** will be organise rooms etc. We shall also be accommodating and feeding the Coach drivers this year. Cooking & equipment organised by Christine and Graham, the 4 cooks being Colin Reid, Gill Thilthorpe, Debra Webber & Carole Baker. Please remember to bring Thermos flask, tea towel and lunch box. No breakfast after 8-30 a.m. Please inform Cooks if early breakfast required. No meals Wednesday - first meal supplied will be Thursday evening.

EQUIPMENT - All assessors to be properly equipped and clothed and be able to cope with any emergency including overnight stay out i.e. Survival bag and Sleeping Bag, first aid kit, emergency rations, clothing. Emergency tent and rucksack to stay on base in case of emergency. Please take your new I.D. card from Martin, if you don't have one please see Martin with passport size photograph of yourself.

BASE CAMP/TELEPHONE DUTY - Groups of assessors and car are arranged on base each day. Their responsibilities are :-

1. Full responsibility for all young people not on Expedition, including those camping at Snowdon View. Also the collection of campsite fees from those at Snowdon View - £ 1-25 each per night.
2. Preparation of groups about to start expeditions, ensuring they all have their I.D. cards, orange cards and emergency 'phone no. and that they are ready in good time for transport to their start point.
3. To arrange manning of the telephone from 9 a.m. until the last group has finished each day and to ensure that at all times one car and assessors are available for emergencies.

TELEPHONING IN - Make sure all groups, especially those leaving en route on Thursday, have the number. Each group of assessors **MUST** phone in regularly, i.e.:- 1. after every check. 2. At least every 2 hours. 3. Before leaving an area. 4. Before returning to base.

ASSESSING TECHNIQUES - The method of assessing will be the same as previous years. Groups should only be contacted at campsites in the evening, except in cases of emergency. Assessors to make visual contact only at all other checkpoints and collect orange cards. Assessing forms to be filled in completely and returned to the group files on base each evening.

SERVICE - A brief informal meeting will be held on each evening at approx. 8-30p.m. this will include a brief devotional period to round off the day.

LOGS & LOG MEETING - A separate list shows groups of Assessors receiving logs. Logs to be studied by that Group and returned if necessary for correction. All logs to be brought with Record Books to the logs meeting at **Alan Fishwicks, 14 Bowermount Rd, Maidstone** on Wednesday 6th June at 7-30 p.m.
