Final arrangements have been made for the Silver & Gold level expeditions in Snowdonia at Easter. The travelling arrangements are as follows:-

Coach and Mini buses depart at 9 a.m. on WEDNESDAY 27th MARCH from LEYBOURNE LAY-BY, LEYBOURNE, Nr WEST MALLING. (Map. Ref. 690590 - on A228 just south of M20 Junction 4).

To ensure a prompt departure time please be there 30 minutes before the departure time. This is to give time for loading.

It is expected we shall arrive back in Kent at approximately 12 midnight /1 a.m. Sunday 31st March. I suggest that you arrange to 'phone your parents or BB/GB Officer from the motorway stop on the way home to give them a more accurate expected time of arrival.

The Expedition fee is :- Gold level £36.00, Silver level £34.00. An equipment list, parents consent form and application form are enclosed.

The completed application form and parents consent form, accompanied by the appropriate remittance MUST reach me NO LATER than MONDAY 4th MARCH 1991. Cheques/P.O's should be made payable to :- N.W. KENT BB. DEA Expedition.

Any boy/girl who is not a member of the Boys' Brigade will have received two indemnity forms. These must be duly filled in and one returned with your application form, the other being retained by you.

Parents consent forms must be returned by all participants, even those over 18 years of age as they carry important medical information.
